A broad look at GRE

- Three Sections :
 - ❖ Verbal
 - ❖ Quantitative
 - ❖ Analytical writing (NEW)

Verbal Section

- analyze and evaluate written material and synthesize information obtained from it.
- analyze relationships among component parts of sentences
- recognize relationships between words and concepts

Quantitative Section

- understand basic concepts of arithmetic, algebra, geometry, and data analysis
- reason quantitatively
- solve problems in a quantitative setting

Analytical Writing

- **articulate complex ideas clearly and effectively**
- **examine claims and accompanying evidence**
- **support ideas with relevant reasons and examples**
- **sustain a well-focused, coherent discussion**
- **control the elements of standard written English (this factor plays a role only to the extent that poor writing skills impede readers' understanding of the argument)**

What is the analytical writing section like?

- The analytical writing section consists of two analytical writing tasks:
 - a 45-minute "Present Your Perspective on an Issue" task and
 - a 30-minute "Analyze an Argument" task.
