

David Hitchcock of the University of South Carolina

Recipient of the 2024 William D. Warde Statistics Education Award

David Hitchcock has taught for 20 years as a faculty member in the statistics department at the University of South Carolina, teaching a range of courses from 200-person introductory courses to small graduate-level courses, and supervising the research of 14 Ph.D. students, 17 master's students, and 16 senior thesis students. He has served as an advisor for the Mu Sigma Rho chapter at South Carolina and the Statistics Club. He developed an innovative discussion-based History of Statistics course in 2023; an article describing this course is appearing in *The American Statistician*. His students' successes during their time in school and beyond are what have brought him the most happiness in his career.
