#### News from the Chapters

# Virginia Alpha Chapter - Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University

This past year there were 6 BS, 10 MS and 6 PhD degrees awarded. Graduates accepted jobs with companies or institutions like Du Pont, Miami University (OH), Auburn University, Dade MicroScan, 3M, and the CDC. Two students opted to continue to graduate school. Salaries for the new hires ranged from \$50K to \$80K.
